NURSERY CAREGIVER JOB DESCRIPTION

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week Every Other Week Once A Month

A nursery caregiver is someone who is dedicated to the missions' of The Chapel and its' Children's Ministry, loves each child in their care, and is able to handle a fair amount of chaos! Through a relationship with them, the caregiver introduces infants and toddlers to the church environment. A nursery caregiver is someone who cares about each family that enters their room and prays for them continually.

So how do I become a Nursery Caregiver?

It's easy! The first step is to fill out a ministry volunteer application. After you are background checked, you will attend an orientation to hear more about Chapel Kids and the specific needs that we have. After the orientation, you will go through training and with the help of a Chapel Kids staff member, determine the age group in which you will best fit and thrive. Because nursery caregiver's play an important role in the first impression many families have of The Chapel, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and direct you while providing on the job training. You may wish to "shadow" a volunteer in many areas of children's ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is a nursery caregiver, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will ensure that the new nursery caregiver is properly equipped.
